Prof. Chun-Jen Liu received his M.D. from the National Taiwan University in 1992 and his training in Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology and Hepatology from the same University Hospital between 1992 and 1997. Later on, he received his Ph.D. from the Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine at National Taiwan University College of Medicine in 2003.

PUBLICATION

Professor Liu's professional interests focus on the role of host and viral factors in the pathogenesis and natural/treatment outcomes of chronic hepatitis B and C. He has published around 200 peer-reviewed research articles, and some in top journals including Gastroenterology, Hepatology, Gut, and Journal of Hepatology. Professor Liu is also the principal investigator of several multicenter clinical trials involving patients with chronic viral hepatitis B and C, and dual chronic hepatitis B and C.
