- He joined the Thomas E. Starzl Transplantation Institute in 1994.
- He joined Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh in 1997 as co-director of Pediatric Liver and Intestine Transplantation.
- He became the Chief of Pediatric Transplantation in 2004.
- Dr. Mazariegos is author of more than 180 peer reviewed articles and numerous book chapters, with many focusing on long term outcomes or other aspects of intestinal transplantation.
- Dr. Mazariegos serves as President-Elect for the Intestinal Transplant Association (ITA), as Chair of Studies in Pediatric Liver Transplantation (SPLIT), an international registry of pediatric liver transplantation and as Councilor of the International Pediatric Transplant Association (IPTA). He is also an active member of the American Surgical Association and the Society for University Surgeons.

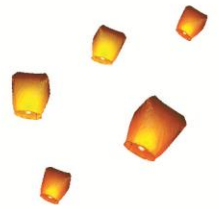
