Go Wakabayashi, earned his degrees from Keio University School of Medicine, Tokyo Japan. He was trained at Department of Surgery at Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School. After working as an assistant professor at Department of Surgery, Keio University School of Medicine, he was recruited as professor and chairman of Department of Surgery at Iwate Medical University School of Medicine in 2005. From April 2015, he got appointment as a Senior Consultant of Surgery at Ageo Central General Hospital, which is a flagship hospital among 6,000 beds hospital complex near Tokyo. His expertise includes Hepato-pancreatic Biliary Surgery, liver transplantation, and laparoscopic surgery. He has operated more than 150 cases of living liver transplantation and over 3000 cases of HPB surgery and laparoscopic surgery. He also practices conventional HPB surgery and aggressive surgery as well. He holds numerous important positions in Japanese and international surgical societies.

He has published over 290 peer-reviewed articles and total impact factor is over 1000. He is an opinion leader in the field of laparoscopic liver resection and published consensus statements as a first author in the April issue of Ann Surg 2015.
